We are Radiant People.

Radiant means: "sending out light; shining or glowing brightly"

Radiant People shine the light of Jesus for others to see the way to God.

Luke 11:33–36 (NLT) [Fresh Start Bible, Page 897]]

Radiant People reflect the right light because they are filled with the right light.

What we gaze at, we are guided toward.

Romans 12:1-2(NLT) [Fresh Start Bible, Page 1000]

What we behold we become. How do you renew your mind?

- 1. Recognize the lie
- 2. Relax by slowing down & breathing deeply
- 3. Recite a Scripture repeatedly
- 4. Repeat as needed

We renew our minds so we become the radiant people who reflect the proper light, and become royal priests who minister to the Lord and on behalf of the Lord. (1 Peter 2:9)

PRACTICING THE WAY

As disciples of Jesus, we know our allegiance to Him as King is expressed in our daily practice. We are not pursuing perfection, but want to practice our faith each day. These practices will point you toward spiritual formation as an apprentice (disciple) to Jesus.

Start the Fresh Start Pathway with a friend.

Recite the Radiant Liturgy each morning:

We are the radiant people of God. We are consumed with the preeminence, purity, and beauty of the holy God who was before the beginning. He provided Redemption for us, making a way into a relationship that produces unimaginable renewal in our lives, and eventually, the world itself. So we gather to encounter His presence and be transformed into the radiant people of God. We are His apprentices and ambassadors. We are full of joy and peace and love. We are the people of God in full pursuit of the person of Jesus, the power of His presence, and actively walking in the pathway of His teachings. We long to see Him create renewal in the place we live. We are passionate about Jesus. We are radiant.

Talk it Over (with friends, a spouse, or connect group)

- Read Luke 11:33-36 . What do you notice within this passage?
- Sunday's message was about letting the right light into our lives. Did anything in the message stand out to you or stir a question within you?
- Have you ever had a gullible moment where you got fooled by something that seem real or true?
- We all want to shine the right light. Pastor used different types of light to reference various types of people's faith. Which light do you relate to the most or reflects your life of faith the most?
- Read Romans 12:1-2. What do you notice in these verses?
- What are some mindsets you have that are directing your life?
- What is one lie you find yourself battling the most? What is a Scripture you can use to combat that? If you're having trouble finding a verse, ask the group to help you find one.
